


## We offer you help

**All people have the right to a life in dignity, free from coercion and control.**

- **If you cannot** negotiate working conditions, do not receive pay and cannot hand in your notice and leave.
- **If you do not** feel you are free to influence your own life or make decisions about your own body.

**That is not ok.**

It might be human trafficking.

## This is human trafficking

Have you been forced or tricked into selling sex, working without pay, stealing or committing other crimes, or begging?

That is human trafficking. It is not ok.

Everybody has the right to freedom.

Nobody has the right to make other people act for their benefit, satisfaction or pleasure. Any person who subjects another to this is violating Swedish law and human rights.

## What are your rights?

You have the right to get help if you are a victim of human trafficking. You have the right to:

- ✓ Suitable and secure accommodation
- ✓ Material support (food and clothing etc.)
- ✓ Essential healthcare
- ✓ Psychological support
- ✓ Legal advice and information
- ✓ Translator and interpreter

Our goal is to give you access to these human rights. We work with *Platform Civil Society Against Human Trafficking*. Together, we want to offer help and protection for you, your children and your family. All help is free of charge and is based on your needs.

## Some people who have received help:

*Evelina from Bulgaria was forced to carry out unpaid work every day. She turned to a help centre to escape her situation. She was given help to find a safe place to live, food, rest and clothes. She was given information about her rights and other options.*

*The police discovered Nadja from Romania when they were investigating people buying sex. Nadja was placed in accommodation where she was given help to recover after being exploited into prostitution. Her children were also given help to process what they had seen and experienced, and Nadja was given help to submit a police report.*

*Anxa from Albania was captured and drugged by an organised gang who then forced her into prostitution. She was pregnant and fled to Sweden with her 3 year-old son.*

*Via Platform's support programme, she was given accommodation, counselling, information, clothes, food and help with the asylum process.*
